The medication has a long half life compared to other benzodiazepines like alprazolam or lorazepam. The half life of diazepam ranges from twenty to one hundred hours, and its active metabolites stay in your system even longer. This long duration means you do not need to take it as frequently as shorter acting benzodiazepines.

The medication is approved for four main conditions. Generalized anxiety disorder involving persistent worry that interferes with daily functioning responds well to diazepam. Muscle spasms caused by conditions like cerebral palsy, multiple

sclerosis, or spinal cord injuries constitute another approved use. Alcohol withdrawal management is a serious medical application where diazepam reduces the risk of seizures and calms the overexcited nervous system. Seizure disorders including myoclonic seizures, absence seizures, and focal seizures may be treated with diazepam either as regular maintenance therapy or as rescue medication.

How To Use Diazepam

Using diazepam correctly is essential for both safety and effectiveness. The medication should be taken exactly as prescribed by your doctor. Do not change your dose or stop taking diazepam without consulting your healthcare provider first.

For anxiety disorders, doctors typically start with a low dose of two to five milligrams taken two to four times daily. The dose may be gradually increased based on your response. Most adults respond to total daily doses between four and forty milligrams depending on the severity of symptoms.

For muscle spasms, the typical dose is two to ten milligrams taken three to four times daily. The higher end of this range is usually reserved for patients with significant spasticity from neurological conditions.

For alcohol withdrawal, the dose varies significantly based on the severity of withdrawal symptoms. Your doctor will determine the appropriate dose and schedule, often starting with ten milligrams taken three to four times on the first day and gradually reducing over subsequent days.

For seizure disorders, the dose is highly individualized. Your doctor will determine the minimum effective dose based on your seizure type, frequency, and response to other medications.

Take diazepam with or without food as directed. Some people prefer taking it with food if stomach upset occurs. The tablets should be swallowed whole with water. Do not crush, chew, or break the tablets unless they have a score line indicating they can be safely split.

Take your doses at evenly spaced intervals throughout the day to maintain consistent levels of medication in your bloodstream. If you take diazepam once daily, take it at the same time each day. If you take it multiple times daily, space the doses evenly.

Side Effects Of Diazepam

Like all medications, diazepam can cause side effects. Not everyone experiences them, and many side effects improve as your body adjusts to the medication.

Common side effects affecting more than ten percent of users include drowsiness, fatigue, muscle weakness, and lack of coordination. These effects are dose related and tend to be most noticeable when you first start taking the medication or when your dose increases. Some patients experience dry mouth, nausea, blurred vision, or changes in appetite.

Less common side effects affect between one and ten percent of users. These include confusion, depression, headache, slurred speech, tremor, and constipation. Some patients report changes in libido, difficulty urinating, or skin rashes.

Serious side effects requiring immediate medical attention are rare. These include jaundice or yellowing of the skin and eyes indicating liver problems, severe skin reactions, hallucinations, agitation, aggressive behavior, and memory problems. Respiratory depression is a serious risk especially when diazepam is combined with other central nervous system depressants.

Paradoxical reactions occur in a small number of patients. Instead of calming down, these patients become agitated, aggressive, or anxious. This is more common in children, elderly patients, and those with psychiatric disorders. If this occurs, stop taking diazepam and contact your doctor.

Long term use of diazepam at high doses can lead to physical dependence and tolerance. Your doctor will monitor you regularly and may recommend periodic attempts to reduce your dose or stop the medication if appropriate.

Warnings

Diazepam carries several important warnings that every patient should understand before taking this medication.

The FDA requires a Boxed Warning on diazepam regarding the risk of misuse, dependence, and withdrawal. Benzodiazepines have a high potential for abuse. Misuse can cause serious respiratory depression, coma, and death especially when combined with opioids or alcohol. Physical dependence occurs with regular use for more than a few weeks. Abrupt discontinuation can cause life threatening withdrawal symptoms including seizures.

Another Boxed Warning addresses the risk of concurrent use with opioids. Combining diazepam with opioids can cause profound sedation, respiratory depression, coma, and death. The FDA recommends avoiding co prescribing these medications whenever possible. If they must be used together, the lowest effective doses and shortest durations should be prescribed.

Diazepam can cause severe withdrawal symptoms including seizures. Withdrawal typically begins within one to four days after the last dose for short acting benzodiazepines, but because diazepam has a long half life, withdrawal may not

begin for several days. Symptoms include rebound anxiety, insomnia, irritability, sweating, rapid heartbeat, hand tremors, and in severe cases, seizures and delirium.

The medication should not be used by patients with myasthenia gravis, severe liver disease, narrow angle glaucoma, or a known allergy to diazepam or any benzodiazepine. It should also be avoided by patients with severe respiratory insufficiency or sleep apnea.

Pregnant women should not take diazepam especially during the first and third trimesters. Use during early pregnancy increases the risk of congenital malformations. Use during late pregnancy can cause floppy infant syndrome, withdrawal symptoms in the newborn, and respiratory depression.

Before Taking This Medicine

Before your doctor prescribes diazepam, you need to provide a complete medical history. Do not take diazepam if you are allergic to diazepam or any other benzodiazepine.

Tell your doctor if you have glaucoma, specifically narrow angle glaucoma. Diazepam can worsen this condition. Patients with open angle glaucoma may be able to take diazepam if they are receiving appropriate treatment.

Discuss any breathing problems including sleep apnea, asthma, chronic bronchitis, or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. Diazepam can suppress breathing, which may worsen these conditions.

Tell your doctor if you have liver disease especially cirrhosis. Diazepam is metabolized by the liver, and accumulation can occur in patients with impaired liver function. Your dose may need to be significantly reduced.

Discuss any history of drug or alcohol addiction. Benzodiazepines have abuse potential, and patients with a history of substance use disorders require careful monitoring.

Tell your doctor if you have kidney disease, myasthenia gravis, porphyria, or a seizure disorder. Some of these conditions may be worsened by diazepam, while others affect how the medication is processed.

Tell your doctor about all other medications you take including prescription drugs, over the counter products, vitamins, and herbal supplements. Do not take diazepam with opioids, other benzodiazepines, muscle relaxants, antipsychotics, or alcohol.

If you are pregnant, plan to become pregnant, or are breastfeeding, discuss this with your doctor before taking diazepam. The medication can harm your baby and passes into breast milk.

How To Take Diazepam Online

What To Avoid

Several substances and activities should be avoided while taking diazepam to prevent dangerous interactions and side effects.

Avoid alcohol completely while taking diazepam. Alcohol increases the sedative effects of diazepam and can cause dangerous respiratory depression. The combination also impairs judgment and coordination more severely than either substance alone. Never drink alcohol while taking diazepam.

Avoid driving or operating machinery until you know how diazepam affects you. The medication can cause drowsiness, dizziness, and impaired coordination. These

Cognitive impairment including memory problems, confusion, and difficulty concentrating can occur especially at higher doses. These effects are usually reversible when the medication is stopped. Let your doctor know if you experience any cognitive changes.

Paradoxical reactions including agitation, aggression, and increased anxiety occur in less than one percent of patients. These reactions are more common in children, elderly patients, and those with psychiatric disorders. If you experience these, stop taking diazepam and contact your doctor.

Liver problems are rare but serious. Signs include yellowing of the skin or eyes, dark urine, severe nausea, and upper stomach pain. Contact your doctor immediately if you notice any of these symptoms.

Withdrawal symptoms occur when diazepam is stopped abruptly after regular use. Symptoms include rebound anxiety, insomnia, irritability, sweating, rapid heartbeat, hand tremors, and in severe cases seizures. Withdrawal from diazepam should always be done under medical supervision.

The 5 mg tablet is yellow and round, which is why diazepam is sometimes called yellow Valium. The 10 mg tablet is blue and round. Oral solution is available as 5 mg per 5 mL.

Generic diazepam is available and is bioequivalent to brand name Valium. The FDA requires that generic medications deliver the same amount of active ingredient within a narrow range compared to the brand name product. Many insurance plans cover generic diazepam with lower copays than the brand name.

Diazepam is classified as a Schedule IV controlled substance under the Controlled Substances Act. This classification means the Drug Enforcement Administration recognizes diazepam as having a legitimate medical use but also potential for abuse and physical dependence. Prescriptions for diazepam can be refilled up to five times within six months.
