## **How Many Methadone Pills Are Typically Prescribed**

Prescription quantities for methadone vary significantly based on the condition being treated.

For opioid use disorder in a treatment program, doses typically range from 60mg to 120mg daily. A patient on 80mg daily using 10mg tablets takes 8 tablets per day. For a weekly supply of take home doses, this would be 56 tablets.

Methadone interacts with many medications. Some interactions are life threatening. Combining methadone with benzodiazepines such as Xanax or Valium significantly increases the risk of fatal overdose. Alcohol has the same dangerous interaction.

Other central nervous system depressants including sleep aids, muscle relaxants, and certain antihistamines increase sedative effects. Some medications can increase methadone levels leading to overdose. Others can reduce methadone levels causing withdrawal.

Always provide your physician and pharmacist with a complete list of everything you take including over the counter products and herbal supplements.

## **Recognizing Illegal Operations**

Any website claiming to offer methadone without a prescription is operating illegally. Red flags include no prescription required, shipping from international locations, accepting cryptocurrency or wire transfers, prices significantly below market rates, no pharmacist access, and high pressure sales tactics.

The DEA reports that counterfeit opioid pills sold on unregulated websites often contain fentanyl. Fentanyl is fifty times more potent than heroin. A single counterfeit pill can cause immediate death.

## **Overdose Recognition and Response**

Knowing the signs of opioid overdose saves lives. Signs include small constricted pupils, loss of consciousness, slow or absent breathing, choking or gurgling sounds, limp body, and blue or purple fingernails or lips.

If you suspect an overdose, call 911 immediately. Administer naloxone if available. Naloxone is an opioid antagonist that temporarily reverses the effects of an overdose. It is available without a prescription at most pharmacies.
